FINAL MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC MEETING
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Meeting held on the 10th of March 2009**

Board members present: J. Kieley, T. Petro, M. Darnell

Call to Order by Kieley at 7:06 p.m.

1. Subject: Steve Delahunty met with the Board to request permission for the 10-Mile Pack Monadnock Race to go through Temple. This race will be held on 5/31/09. The race ends on Pack Monadnock and the runners would be running on Webster Hwy, Old Revolutionary Rd to Route 101. Delahunty informed the Board that he has already spoken to Police Chief McTague. The Board supported the race and course through Temple.
2. Subject: Review of the 2009 revised budget for presentation at Town Meeting. Kieley suggested reviewing the comments section of the budget worksheet. Kieley will put together revised comments for the Board's review. The Board discussed making 100 copies of the budget worksheet for Town Meeting. The Administrative Assistant will speak to David Martz, Chairman of the CIP Committee, regarding having copies of the CIP at the Town Meeting.
3. Subject: Kieley informed the Board that he and Tim Fiske, Road Agent, had received information about a grant through the DES to upgrade diesel motors to reduce diesel emissions. Fiske and Kieley attended a seminar to obtain further information. It is possible that a portion of the grader could be covered by this grant. Up to 25% of new equipment could be covered. An application will need to be submitted to the DES by Friday, 3/13/09. Fiske, Kieley and the Administrative Assistant are compiling the required information to submit the application.
4. Subject: Kieley informed the Board that Bev Edwards, Chair of TEEC, has been working on proposals for grants for energy improvement money for the Municipal Building and Library. The Town has also been advised that the Putman Road Bridge would qualify for some of the Federal Stimulus money at 100% of construction costs. Kieley informed Nancy Mayville of the NH-DOT that Temple would be interested in applying for this grant money. Kieley will attend an information meeting on Friday, 3/13/09.
5. Subject: Reviewed and signed vouchers.
6. Subject: The Board signed the appointment form for Police Officer Richard Sprankle.
7. Subject: The Board signed the facilities contract for use of the Temple Elementary School for Town Meeting on 3/14/09.

10. Subject: The Board reviewed the warrant articles for discussion at the 3/14/09 Town Meeting and discussed who should present the different articles. It was determined that T. Fiske and Kieley would speak about article #s 4 and 5 the road grader and refurbishment of the present grader. Kieley will present article #5 – budget. Article #7 is a petition article and will need to be addressed by the proponent. Article #s 8 & 9 – Municipal Bldg roof and Library roof – Kieley will speak to Dave Martz, Chair of the CIP, and request that he speak about these. Article #10 is a petition article and will need to be addressed by the proponent. Article #11 – Road Debris clean-up – T. Fiske and Kieley. Article #12 – Ambulance – Petro. Article #13 – Conservation land and article #14 – Child Advocacy request the Administrative Assistant, D. Harling. Article #15 is a petition article and will need to be addressed by the proponent.
